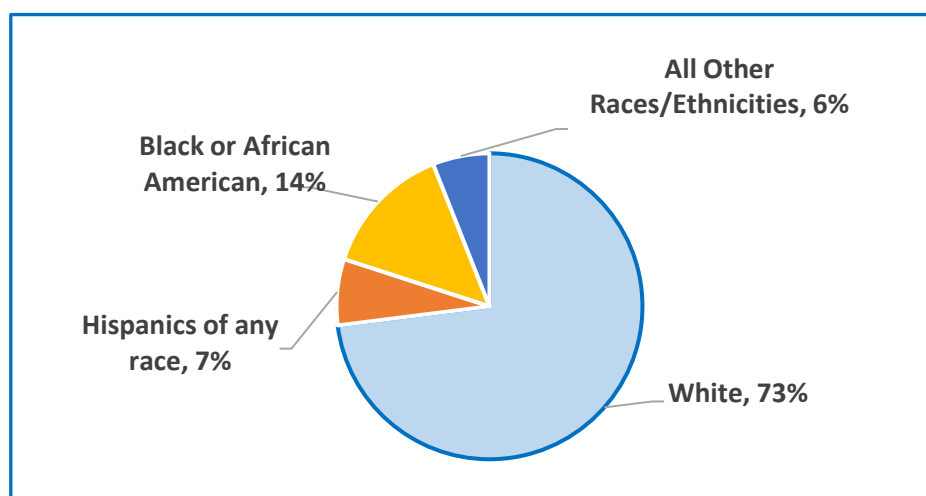

Persistence = Semester to Semester re-enrollment of a specified cohort for students who remain in the program.

A switch between days or evenings in the ASN program or ASN pre-program to program is counted as Persisted.

* As of Fall 2022, CCOD numbers are not combined with ASHT numbers (persistence if it was = 35%). However, CCOD students that transfer to ASHT are considered to be persisting in CCOD.

** Lateral moves between BSN programs are considered persisted (example: BSNP -> BSNA)

% Pre-majors that move on to a degree outside of their intended track are not considered persisted (example: BSNX -> ASNU).
