Mercy College of Ohio does not provide or offer health insurance coverage to students.

Although Mercy College does not require you to have health insurance to enroll in a College program, if you seek a clinical rotation or similar experience at a hospital or other healthcare facility as part of their program, you MAY be separately required by that hospital or facility to obtain and maintain health insurance coverage throughout that rotation or experience. Please contact your program's Clinical Coordinator or Administrator for more information about those requirements before you seek that rotation or experience.

Mercy College recommends that you verify your current health insurance coverage and needs. Please understand if you choose not to obtain and maintain health insurance coverage, or if you lose health insurance coverage for any reason during your program enrollment, you will be solely and financially responsible for all health care costs that you may incur.
