CURRENT COVID-19 NUMBERS

Campus Open with Safety Precautions in Place

The College opened for in-person classes on Monday, January 10, 2022.

Enter Jefferson side of the building (grocery store type doors) with your face covering in place. Face coverings must always be worn while on campus unless alone in a private office.

Please use good hand hygiene and/or hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer stations are on walls throughout campus and will be placed in classrooms and labs.

Anyone not following the guidelines will be subject to the Student Code of Conduct, and employees will be subject to Mercy Health HR guidelines.

If your temperature is 100 degrees or higher or you have COVID symptoms, please **do not come** to campus, and contact the college health nurse.

Cleaning supplies will be provided in all rooms – please clean work/study area before and after finishing work/student, etc.

Our wipes are from different suppliers so please read the directions for use.

Rad Tech students will follow purple and

pink circles to their destinations: purple Jefferson and pink Madison.

Science Lab students will follow Yellow circles to their destination.

EMT/Paramedic students

follow **orange** circles to their destination.

BLS and Polysomnographic

students follow red circles to their destination.

Phlebotomy students

follow **black** circles to their destination.

Nursing students follow

green circles to their destination if on Jefferson second or third floor and follow blue circles to their destination if on Madison second, third, or fourth floor.




SAFETY FIRST

STUDENT SERVICES





Updated Transcript Ordering Process

At the beginning of the pandemic, Mercy College of Ohio changed the transcript ordering process. We now complete all transcript requests through the National Student Clearinghouse. Most transcript requests are fulfilled within 24 hours. We encourage electronic delivery as it is the quickest method and it is free. PLEASE NOTE: We no longer accept or process paper or email transcript requests.

Order your Mercy College Transcript at the following link: https://mercycollege.edu/academics/student-records/transcript-request
You can also go to the Mercy College of Ohio website (Mercycollege.edu) and search for "Transcript" this will take you to the same page. Click on the "Request a Transcript" link, then the green box titled "Order Transcripts"

Complete the next screen with your personal information. Provide your student ID number, or social security number. Answer all the required questions/prompts. (You will not be able to proceed to the next screen until all required information is provided).

On the page titled "Select Transcript and Deliver Details" under "Delivery Information" you can select Electronic Delivery or Mail/United States and there will be no charge. If you select any other delivery options, the cost will be indicated next to the method. On this page, you also have the option to upload any additional documents with your transcript.

On the Checkout page, you will sign electronically, and you will then see an order confirmation page. You will also receive a confirmation email, and if you signed up for text updates, you will receive text messages about your order.

Complete the 2022-23 FAFSA® Form

Use the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form to apply for financial aid for undergraduate and graduate school. If you are planning on attending Mercy College between July 1, 2022, and June 30, 2023, please complete the 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) now. The 2022-23 FAFSA application will be used for determining your financial aid beginning in summer 2022. You will report your 2020 tax information. Apply now at www.studentaid.gov. Mercy College's school code is 030970-00. If you have questions, please contact the financial aid office at financialaid@mercycollege.edu or (419) 251-1219 and we will be glad to assist you.

March and April will continue with entry precautions and hours of operation

All faculty, staff, and students will enter the College through the Jefferson entrance. Please park on the Jefferson side of the building. Masks will be required for all on-campus activities. If you do not have a mask or forget your mask, please ask the receptionist at the front desk who will have some extra masks. The Madison entrance remains closed for the safety and security of our students, faculty, and staff.

Student lounges and study rooms are open for both Toledo and Youngstown students. The second floor Madison building study rooms in Toledo will be closed. Please use at least three feet of social distancing.

Please follow current signage in place.

In Toledo, the hours of operation for fall semester students who wish to study on campus in study rooms or cubicles are 5am-1am Monday through Friday and the College is open from 8am-5pm on Saturday and Sunday for those who wish to study in study rooms or cubicles. Students who need to enter earlier than 8am on the weekends will be able to use their badges to access the College through the Jefferson entrance under the blue canopy.

In Youngstown, the campus is open from 6am-11pm Monday through Sunday and available via badge access during those hours.

The receptionists at the front desk in Toledo will be working 24 hours per day/seven days per week. The receptionists are staffed by Towne Park.
