



Associate of Applied Science in Health Information Technology
Program Outcomes Data

The program changed from Associate of Science (A.S.) in Health Information Technology to Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Health Information Technology in Fall of 2018. The table of Graduation Rates currently lists only students who entered the A.S. program.

Percent completion “within 150% to completion” is the percent of students who complete the two-year program within three years or less of enrollment in the program. Completion rates for some cohorts may be slightly higher than the stated graduation rate as some students graduate after the “150% time to completion.”

The Retention Rate compares (a) the number of program students who return the second listed Fall semester to (b) the number of “potential returning students.” “Potential returning students” are program students who attended the first listed Fall semester and did not graduate before the second listed Fall semester.
