



Associate of Applied Science in Nursing – Toledo and Youngstown

Program Outcomes Data

The program changed from Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) to Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AASN) in Fall of 2018. The table of NCLEX-RN Pass Rate and the table of Graduation Rate are for students who entered the ASN program, except for the 2020 (preliminary) NCLEX-RN Pass Rate, which includes both ASN and AASN graduates.

The ASN Evening/Weekend – Youngstown program first admitted students in Fall 2015. Completion rates for some cohorts may be slightly higher than the stated graduation rate as some students graduate after the “150% time to completion.”

The Retention Rate compares (a) the number of program students who return the second listed Fall semester to (b) the number of “potential returning students.” “Potential returning students” are program students who attended the first listed Fall semester and did not graduate before the second listed Fall semester.

Students who switch from Day to Evening or Evening to Day are counted as “retained” in the original program.

The Fall 2016 – Fall 2017 and Fall 2017 – Fall 2018 data are for students who entered the ASN program. The Fall 2018 - Fall 2019 and Fall 2019 – Fall 2020 data include continuing ASN students and new AASN students.
