## Distance Education Course Enrollments

Duplicate count: A student is counted for each course in which she or he is enrolled.
An online or distance education course primarily uses the internet to deliver instruction either synchronously or asynchronously.
Hybrid: A hybrid course delivers instruction through land-based class meetings and the internet. A typical hybrid course is $50 \%$ land-based and $50 \%$ online. However, the online component may range from $40-99 \%$ of total class instruction.
