(renews every two years)



Requirement applies to **COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER** students ONLY.

Community Health Worker students must provide *Heartsaver® CPR AED* certification from ONE of the following:

- a. American Heart Association (AHA)
- b. American Red Cross (ARC)
- c. American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) (offered at various locations)

Courses from any other providers will not be accepted.

Copy must be front AND back of the card, and the card must be signed. If an eCard was issued, submit a clear PDF of the document. Certification is valid for two years. The renewal date will be based on the expiration date of the card.

Certificates OR letters from the provider are accepted temporarily (for 60 days) until the card arrives. A new requirement will be created for you to submit your actual card 21 days prior to the expiration date.

Certification is valid for **two years** and must be renewed prior to the expiration date for student to remain compliant for clinicals (this may apply if you already have certification that will expire during your Community Health Worker program.

The renewal date will be based on the expiration date of the card.

Student name is required on documentation for approval.
