- New students – apply for admissions and be accepted to the College

- New and Current students - submit your FAFSA (necessary to determine financial need for need based scholarships) by February 28, 2020 at www.fafsa.gov
 - Mercy's school code is: 030970-00
- Complete scholarship application (only **one** application is necessary) on-line at <http://www.mercycollege.edu/scholarships> (deadline is February 28, 2020)
- Current Mercy College **Toledo** nursing clinical students – submit two (2) nursing clinical reference letters to the financial aid office by the scholarship deadline (Nursing scholarships)
 - Reference letters can be submitted to: financialaid@mercycollege.edu
- New accepted students who are graduates of Cardinal Stritch or Waite High School - who are involved, engaged and demonstrates leadership:
 - a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or leader describing the applicant's involvement (necessary for consideration for the Hanley scholarship)
