This scholarship was established to assist direct from high school students who attend Mercy College full-time in a degree program (associate or bachelor).

Eligibility:

Direct from high school students with a minimum 2.0 high school GPA

Amount:

\$500.00 per semester; renewable by maintaining full-time enrollment and a minimum 2.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Academic Scholarship

This scholarship was established to help direct from high school students who attend Mercy College full-time in a degree program (associate or bachelor).

Eligibility:

Direct from high school students with a minimum 3.0 high school GPA

Amount:

\$2500.00 per semester; renewable by maintaining full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Dean's Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist direct from high school students who attend Mercy College full-time in a degree program (associate or bachelor).

Eligibility:

Direct from high school students with a minimum 3.5 high school GPA

Amount:

\$3500.00 per semester; renewable by maintaining full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Presidential Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist direct from high school students who attend Mercy College full-time in a degree program (associate or bachelor).

Fliaihility.

Direct from high school students with a minimum 3.90 high school GPA

*Award cannot be combined with Mercy First, Mercy Academic or Mercy Dean's scholarships Amount:

100% tuition and fees per semester, excluding health insurance and book charges; must maintain enrollment in first degree scholarship was offered for, maintain full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy TPS Presidential Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist one Toledo Public Schools (TPS) direct from high school student who attends Mercy College full-time in a degree program (associate or bachelor).

Mercy College Merit Scholarships

Eligibility:

Direct from high school students with a minimum 3.75 high school GPA

*Award cannot be combined with Mercy First, Mercy Academic or Mercy Dean's scholarships Amount:

Minimally one TPS direct from high school graduate will receive a 100% tuition and fees scholarship per semester, excluding health insurance and book charges; must maintain enrollment in first degree scholarship was offered for, maintain full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Alumni Dependent Scholarship

This scholarship was established for dependents of Alumni of Mercy College of Ohio. The dependent must be a first-year student (*no prior college*) within one year of high school graduation. *Eliqibility:*

Student must be newly accepted to Mercy College in one of the following programs: Biology Degree, Health Science associate degree, Nursing (Associate or Bachelor Pre-Licensure), Radiology associate degree, Health Information associate degree

High school GPA must be 2.7 or higher

*Award cannot be combined with Mercy Presidential scholarship

Amount:

\$1500.00 per semester; renewable by maintaining full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Transfer Student Scholarship

This scholarship was established to help students who have attended another college previously and are new transfer students to Mercy College in a degree program.

Eligibility:

Student must be newly accepted program ready to Mercy College in either an associate or bachelor's degree program offered at the Toledo campus.

Transfer GPA must be 3.0 or higher.

Amount:

\$500.00 per semester; renewable by maintaining part-time enrollment (6 credits or higher) and a minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA.

Mercy Certificate Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist credit-bearing certificate program new students at Mercy College.

Eligibility:

New Toledo student accepted into one of the following eligible certificate programs: Community Health Worker, Medical Coding, Paramedic, Polysomnographic Technology

Either a 3.0 transfer GPA or 3.0 high school GPA for students with no prior college *Amount*:
