

Resources for Obtaining Health Requirements

Even with a local Provider, you may need other resources to meet all the clinical health requirements. Students have several options to meet the required physical, Tuberculosis (TB) test, necessary titers and/or vaccines. When meeting with a new medical provider, make sure you take documentation of prior medical history and list of current prescriptions with you to the appointment.

Some locations may not be able to provide all services and may not accept insurance, so inquire ahead of time.
