Fall 2015 – Fall 2016	62%
Fall 2016 – Fall 2017	82%
Fall 2017 – Fall 2018	73%
Fall 2018 – Fall 2019	79%

The Retention Rate compares (a) the number of program students who return the second listed Fall semester to (b) the number of “potential returning students.” “Potential returning students” are program students who attended the first listed Fall semester and did not graduate before the second listed Fall semester.
