

Health Records Requirements

TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)

Submit to CastleBranch:

1. Medical documentation of Tdap given at any point within your lifetime. Documentation **MUST** specifically identify TDAP *and* the date TDAP was given.

Some providers, such as the example below from the *Michigan Department of Health and Human Services*, do NOT identify the specific version of the vaccine given on each date.

Documentation which does not clearly identify TDAP will be rejected.

In the example below, a TDAP vaccination would be required because although a vaccine was given within the past 10 years, it cannot be verified that TDAP has been administered.

Not acceptable documentation

2. If Tdap was administered over 10 years ago, documentation of a Tetanus, Td booster, or Tdap within the last 10 years is also required.
 - If Tdap has been administered within the past 10 years, no additional Tetanus or Td booster is needed.
 - If Tetanus or Td booster has been administered within the past 10 years with no evidence of Tdap, a Tdap must be received.
- The renewal date will be set 10 years from the administered date.
