

Mercy College Endowed Scholarship Application Checklist

- Submit the 2024-2025 FAFSA (necessary for need based scholarships) by February 28, 2024, at www.studentaid.gov/fafsa
 - o Mercy's school code is: 030970-00
 - The 2024-2025 FAFSA will open in December 2023
- Complete endowed scholarship application (only **one** application is necessary) on-line at http://www.mercycollege.edu/scholarships (deadline is February 28, 2024)
- Currently enrolled Mercy College undergraduate nursing clinical students submit two (2) nursing clinical instructor reference letters that include the location of where the clinical was completed.
 - Clinical Instructor Reference letters can be submitted to: financialaid@mercycollege.edu
- o 2024 high school graduates:
 - A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or leader describing the applicant's involvement as a leader is recommended.
 - Preference will be given to a graduate from Cardinal Stritch or Waite High School.
