Mercy College's Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Pre-licensure (ABSN) program provides a fast-track to become a BSN-prepared nurse for those who have a bachelor's degree or higher in another field. The 15-month



program will begin in May of 2021 so those interested should contact Mercy College now as space is limited.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The ABSN is a fast-paced, full-time program of study. Due to the rigor of the program outside employment should be limited. Nursing courses are primarily offered during the day with

some elective courses available online. Students will earn a BSN and be eligible to take the NCLEX exam to become a registered nurse.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A bachelor's degree or higher in a field other than nursing from a regionally-accredited four-year college or university.
- 2. Admission to Mercy College of Ohio.
- 3. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Completion of required prerequisite courses prior to beginning the first nursing course See list below.
- 5. Prerequisite math and science courses must have been completed within the past seven (7) years with a grade of C or better.

PREREQUISITE COLLEGE LEVEL COURSES

- Chemistry with lab (4 total credit hours any combination of inorganic, organic and biochemistry)
- Anatomy and Physiology I with lab and Anatomy and Physiology II with lab (8 total credit hours)
- Microbiology with lab (4 credit hours)
- Pathophysiology (3 credit hours)

Those who have already taken these courses or plan to take them from another regionally-accredited institution should contact the admissions office.

DEMAND AND SALARY

The national annual salary for registered nurses ranges from \$47,150 – \$102,990, with the median salary being \$68,450 (BLS.gov). The shortage of nurses in the United States has reached levels not seen in 80 years.

PRIORITY REVIEW DATE FOR ADMISSION

January 15 for a Summer Semester (May) clinical start

FINANCIAL AID

Students use a variety of options to cover the program costs and must also consider living expenses during the 15-month program. As a post-baccalaureate program, ABSN students do not qualify for federal grants. In addition to personal savings or other outside resources, most nursing students rely heavily on financial assistance through federal direct student loans and private educational loans.
